Prepare proposal:

- All requests must include a documented statement of need for the education based on a demonstrated scientific or clinical need. Who will it benefit? How or what is the goal of the education, e.g. increase knowledge, competence, confidence, behavior/practice?
- Include learning objectives, educational design, target audience and a rationale for why the audience is being targeted, outcomes evaluation methodology, and a detailed budget identifying all sources of funding and how grant funds will be used.
- Include evidence of accreditation to provide continuing education credit and/or tax-exempt status.

- Complete all required fields.
- Upload your proposal documentation.

What to expect

Review and funding process:

-  Grants are reviewed on a rolling basis.
-  Grant applications undergo a comprehensive and meticulous review process, which involves evaluation by designated review committees.
J&J Innovative Medicine receives thousands of grant requests annually. Unfortunately, only a small percentage of grants that are submitted for consideration will be funded. Please allow 90 days for grant reviews
-  Grant approval notifications and letters of agreement will be sent via email.
-  Every approved grant is expected to provide periodic outcomes metrics and a final budget reconciliation at the conclusion of the program.
